Pollo Parmigiana - Breaded fried chicken cutlet oven baked with marinara sauce and mozzarella cheese.

Pollo Martriciana - Chicken pieces sauteed with onions, tomatoes, bacon, romano cheese and fresh hot peppers in a tomato cream sauce. Tossed with penne pasta.

Haddock Puttanesca - Broiled haddock sauteed with green and red peppers, onions, olives, tomatoes, capers, crushed red peppers and garlic in a white wine sauce.

Piatto Arabiatta - Chicken pieces, Italian sausages and peppers in a spicy tomato sauce with Romano cheese. Tossed with penne pasta.

Wild Mushroom Ravioli – Raviolis stuffed with wild mushrooms and tossed with sundried tomatoes, kalamata olives and assorted mushrooms. Tossed in a garlic cream sauce. **Add grilled chicken for \$2.99**

Chicken Franchesco -Grilled chicken with fresh diced tomatoes in a garlic wine sauce. Served over fresh grilled mixed vegetables and topped with goat cheese.

Seafood Ravioli - Ravioli stuffed with shrimp, scallops and lobster meat. Tossed in a homemade tomato cream sauce.

Pollo alla Rosy - Chicken pieces sauteed with asparagus, sundried tomatoes, roasted red peppers and fresh basil in a fresh lemon wine sauce. Tossed with penne pasta.

Trio Parmigiana - Breaded eggplant, veal and chicken oven baked and topped with our homemade marinara sauce and mozzarella cheese.

Shrimp Zingerella -Shrimp sauteed with mushrooms, roasted red peppers and fresh garlic in a light marinara sauce. Tossed with linguine pasta.

Shrimp Puttanesca - Shrimp sauteed with green and red peppers, onions, olives, tomatoes, capers, crushed red peppers and garlic in a white wine sauce. Tossed with linguine pasta.
